We are a social business based in Kuta Lombok, focusing on working with women from Kuta area. We aim to provide a safe space for women to come to work while enlightening the Sasak culture and traditions. All of the products here are made out of upcycled sarongs, bought directly from the women in South Lombok and then transformed in our sewing studio in Kuta Lombok. We also have a line of handwoven sarongs, all made traditionally, and we host weekly cultural workshops in our studio with the purpose of introducing Sasak Culture and daily gestures of women in the villages around for tourists who are visiting Lombok, especially in Kuta area.

ABOUT VILLAGE TOUR & WEAVING WORKSHOP

Experience the heart of Lombok village life by walking around the village to see how people store rice, grow crops, and make *Tuak*; learning about local plants and their uses; then, joining local women to learn traditional weaving and try it yourself. The experience ends with a delicious homemade lunch with authentic Sasak food.

WHAT WE DO :

Section 1: Warm Welcome at the Berugak

Your experience begins with a warm introduction to ninē-ninē, our community-driven space dedicated to preserving Sasak culture and empowering local women. While you relax in a *berugak* (traditional Lombok gazebo), you'll enjoy a cup of authentic Lombok coffee and learn about our story and the village you're about to explore.

Section 2: Discover Village Life

Next, you'll be guided to walk around the village to witness daily life and local traditions. You'll see:

- **Rice Attic (*Lumbung*):** Learn how villagers store their rice in traditional rice barns.
- **Tamarin Tree:** Understand why this tree is important for the local community.
- **Village Fields:** Discover what the villagers plant in their fields throughout the year.

- **Village Plants:** See useful plants like bamboo, bananas, and the beautiful *ketujur* flower, and find out how locals use them in daily life.
- **Tuak Making:** Get a glimpse of how *Tuak*, the local traditional alcoholic drink, is made.

Section 3: Weaving Experience

After exploring the village, you'll be introduced to the art of traditional Sasak weaving. You will learn the techniques and stories of weaving in Lombok—then you'll have the chance to try weaving yourself!

Section 4: Lunch with Local Flavors

To complete your experience, we'll serve you a delicious lunch featuring authentic local dishes, prepared by the women of our community. Enjoy a taste of Sasak home-cooked food, made with love and tradition.
